UIE'S SHARE BUY-BACK PROGRAMME

On 20 August 2026, UIE initiated a share buy-back programme with the intention of acquiring treasury shares of up to DKK 150 million before 31 December 2027, cf. Company Announcement No. 13/2026.

UIE initiates a share buy-back programme that will be conducted under the European Commission's Regulation No. 596/2014 of 16 April 2014 (the "Market Abuse Regulation") and the Commission's delegated regulation (EU) 2016/1052 of 8 March 2016, which together constitute the Safe Harbour Regulation.

The maximum amount to be invested by UIE under the Safe Harbour programme is DKK 150 million, and the maximum number of shares to be acquired is 600,000 shares.

The Safe Harbour programme runs from 20 August 2026 and will be concluded no later than 31 December 2027.
