European patent applications include direct European applications and international (PCT) applications that entered the European phase during the reporting period.

To accurately account for the growing propensity from applicants to request early processing of their PCT applications in the regional phase at the EPO (Art 23(2) PCT), the date of request for early processing rather than the 31-month time limit (Art 22 PCT) is now considered as the date of entry in the regional phase.

This adjustment concerns annual statistics on applications filed as from 2016 and may lead to minor variations compared to figures published in the precedent Annual Reports.
