The rapid pace of technological development and the deteriorating security environment are affecting the whole of Europe.

Europe's strategic resilience depends on the free flow of goods, energy and information over sea and across borders.

Influence operations bordering on low-intensity warfare, and operating at the limits of current legal frameworks, pose a challenge to all.

This situation calls for a modern maritime strategy capable of addressing threats of today for the next generations
