# Definitions

## ASK

Available seat kilometers. Number of available passenger seats multiplied by flight distance

## Load Factor

RPK divided by ASK. Describes the utilization of available seats

## Punctuality (D15)

Percentage of flights in own network departing within 15 minutes of scheduled departure time

## Own network

Flights operated by Norse Atlantic

## RPK

Revenue passenger kilometers. Number of sold seats multiplied by flight distance

## Completion

Percentage of scheduled flights that operated

## TRASK

Passenger and cargo revenue in own network divided by ASK and reported in US cents. A measure of average revenue per available seat kilometer (unit revenue)

## Charter/ACMI

Flights operated by IndiGo subject to ACMI agreement and by others subject to charter agreements. Load factors are counted as 100% since Norse has no commercial exposure to the number of passengers carried.
