## **Nimlas Sweden continues its growth journey and acquires Uppsala Elcentral AB.**

The acquisition is in line with the growth strategy 5-50-500, which aims to reach SEK 5 billion in revenue, add 50 new companies, and achieve SEK 500 million in profit. The electrical sector is an important part of this growth, with a target of reaching SEK 1 billion in electrical services revenue in the coming years.
