

## Kai Johan Jiang

Kai Johan Jiang is an entrepreneur and a company executive with business interests mainly in China and Sweden. He is the founder and majority shareholder of National Modern Energy Holdings Ltd. (NME Holdings), the holding company for State Power Group, which is a group of companies that since 2004 has made pioneering efforts to develop clean energy sources in China. Today, the Group has 28 biofuel power plants in operation across China, with an additional nine plants planned or under construction. State Power Group has a total staff of about 7,000 and also conducts advanced technology research and development in bioenergy, wind power and energy storage (batteries).

Through NME Holdings, Kai Johan is the majority shareholder in National Electric Vehicle Sweden AB.

A Swedish citizen, Kai Johan Jiang was born 1965 in the Chinese Shandong Province. He first came to Sweden in 1989 to study at Mälardalen University. Together with the County Governor at the time, Jan Rydh, Kai Johan established a town twinning relationship between the Shandong Province and the county of Västmanland.

Kai Johan Jiang served as a senior adviser to the Volvo Group 1993-2000.

In 2004 he founded National Modern Energy and State Power Group.

In 2008 he was awarded the Ernst & Young Emerging Entrepreneur of the Year award in China.
