Background

During the period 2009-2013, Denmark is deeply engaged in a grand-scale design project at the UN - highlighting one of the great icons of Danish design history, Finn Juhl, as well as contemporary Danish designers. Designer duo Kasper Salto and Thomas Sigsgaard have been chosen for the commission to refurbish the restored Trusteeship Council Chamber in the UN Conference Building, a longstanding icon of mid-century modern design. Denmark's wish is that the finished chamber will be not only a model example of Danish design tradition, but also showcase the best of contemporary Danish design.

On the occasion of the restoration, refurbishment and Finn Juhl's Centennial taking place this year, the Consulate General of Denmark has launched the design effort "Living the Legacy – Designing the Future," highlighting both the heritage and the contemporary designers inspired by it.

Selected from the winners and nominees at Danish Design Award 2012, we have partnered with Parsons to invite 8 young designers from Demark to participate in **Danish Design Review, New York**. The Danish Design Award spans industrial design B-to-B, industrial design B-to C, furniture and textiles, service and experience design, digital design and graphic design.
