thyssenkrupp Test and Qualification Tower

In the United States, nearly 1,200 employees develop, test and manufacture the elevator product line. The manufacturing facility is the only elevator factory in the world to hold a LEED® for Existing Building: Operations and Maintenance Gold Certification from the U.S. Green Building Council. The research and development operation includes a 138-foot test and qualification tower that features a penthouse machine room and observation deck. There, engineers can test for qualification and global test standards, codes and compliance testing as well as product verification and validation. Built in 1964, the test tower houses 14 hoistways used for testing a broad spectrum of thyssenkrupp Elevator systems, including:

- Mid-rise freight elevator
- Five low-rise traction elevator
- Two hydraulic elevators
- Safety Drop Tower
