We remain committed to our target of net-zero carbon emissions by 2045, both in our own operations and in our value chain. The sustainability report provides an update on progress towards achieving our climate targets as well as information on our work with sustainability.

We also give an insight into some of our most exciting projects we worked on during the year.
