In keeping with tradition, the Swedish Academy will set the date for its announcement of the Nobel Prize in Literature later.

Each 2005 Nobel Prize will amount to 10.0 million Swedish kronor (2004: MSEK 10.0). In other words the sum of the five Nobel Prizes (Physics, Chemistry, Physiology or Medicine, Literature and Peace) will be MSEK 50.0. In addition, The Bank of Sweden (Sveriges Riksbank) Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel will amount to MSEK 10.0.
